## Applying to Ontario University Programs, 2025 - 2026

#### **IMPORTANT**

If you are applying for a **January 2026 program**, contact the university directly BEFORE deciding if applying for OUAC Eligibility through TVO ILC is right for you, based on the deadlines for the program.

If you are applying for a **Fall 2026 undergraduate program**, complete and submit your OUAC application BEFORE starting the TVO ILC Eligibility process. Don't forget to add TVO ILC to the Academic Background section of your OUAC application.

### Helpful Information for submitting your OUAC Application

### Before you submit your OUAC Application:

- Research <u>Ontario Universities</u> and research <u>Ontario University Programs</u>. Here you will find important information about programs, admission requirements, financing (fees and applications) and the application process.
- Participate in virtual tours, events, and webinars found on the OUAC website.
- Connect with university representatives and access online resources.
- Determine the program requirements (including prerequisites and additional admission criteria) and **review the deadlines**. Deadlines vary by institution and program.

## How to Apply:

- Review the <u>Application Guide</u> to create your OUAC account. Be sure to provide a valid OEN
  (Ontario Education Number) and ensure your name is consistent with what TVO ILC has on
  file as we will be transmitting this data to OUAC.
- Review <u>Important Dates</u> for mark submission deadlines. Complete midterms or finals at least **two weeks prior** to OUAC mark submission deadlines.
- Submit and pay for your completed OUAC application by the **January 15, 2026** deadline. It is possible to apply after this date but only to programs with available space.

# AFTER you have submitted your OUAC Application, proceed to the OUAC Eligibility form on your TVO ILC Dashboard and follow these steps:

1. Click on the OUAC Eligibility Form tab found on your TVO ILC Dashboard through which you will answer questions which will determine if you are eligible for electronic marks transmission to OUAC. If the OUAC Eligibility Form tab is not visible on your dashboard, please call TVO ILC.

To be eligible for electronic marks transmission through TVO ILC, you need to be *able to earn your OSSD* by August 2026 (June is preferred for competitive programs).

You will be asked to upload an official OST when submitting your OUAC eligibility to TVO ILC. An official transcript must be on green transcript paper, signed, and sealed/stamped by the institution issuing the transcript. This must be your most recent transcript. Colour scans are ideal.

If you do not have an official OST, you must request one from your previous high school.

If TVO ILC has been your only school where you have earned credits, upload the following statement in place of the OST: "I have only earned credits at TVO ILC."

- 2. Answer the eligibility questions. If you answered a question incorrectly, you may call TVO ILC to have your OUAC Eligibility Form tab reset.
- 3. If you are eligible for electronic marks transmission, you will receive an email with next steps including how to add Projected Courses and providing consent to share information with OUAC. Please allow 3 to 5 business days to process your request.
  - If you have already earned your OSSD, you will receive instructions to have your previous school email a copy of your transcript directly to OUAC. TVO ILC will upload your ILC course enrollments, projected courses (if any), midterm and final marks.

- If you will earn your OSSD this year through TVO ILC, all your Grade 11 and 12 U and M marks and your TVO ILC course enrollments, projected courses (if any), midterm and final marks will be uploaded to OUAC.
- 4. If you are not eligible for electronic marks transmission because you are determined to be a Group B OUAC applicant, you will need to send your marks directly to institutions through the Request Documents - Self Serve tab (for confirmations of enrollment and midterms) or the Request Documents tab (for final marks) on your TVO ILC Dashboard.

## **Applying to Universities outside of Ontario**

• Visit <u>Universities Canada</u> and contact the Universities *directly* for deadlines and requirements. Some Canadian universities outside of Ontario can receive marks data through OUAC. Check with the universities for further application details.
