Education Documents from TVO ILC

- Use the 'Request Documents – Self Serve' tab on your dashboard to request *confirmation of enrolments and midterm marks* be sent to OCAS and the 'Request Documents' tab to send *final marks*. Please include your OCAS application number and send to service@ocas.ca.
- OCAS automatically shares your academic history electronically to the colleges to which you have applied.
- You will need to send transcripts from your previous school to OCAS separately either by having your previous school email them to service@ocas.ca or through the OCAS transcript feature that is available in the application.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO OCAS APPLICANTS WHO ARE ALSO OUAC APPLICANTS:

If you have successfully met OUAC eligibility and TVO ILC has confirmed that we will be uploading your academic data to OUAC, you do not need to separately request education documents to be sent to OCAS. TVO ILC will upload your academic data to OCAS electronically according to the [Important Dates](#) set by OCAS.
